



The Abt-led **USAID Health Service Delivery (HSD) Activity**

is helping the Jordanian Ministry of Health (MOH) facilitate customized reproductive, maternal, newborn, and child health services at national, sub-national and local points of public and private service. The Activity is also supporting the MOH to reinforce a resilient COVID-19 response in Jordan through interventions targeting health facilities, health care providers, and communities.

Jordan's Maternal Mortality Surveillance and Response system—established by the Abt-led USAID HSD

activity and the MOH—found **unnecessary cesarean sections** to be a contributing factor to maternal mortality, prompting a national program to **reduce the number of procedures.**

FOSTERING A RESILIENT COVID-19 RESPONSE FROM THE GOJ



The Abt-led USAID HSD activity worked with Jordan's MOH to co-develop clinical guidance and protocols

for COVID-19 case management used to **train 2,000 health care providers from 129 facilities** by Sept 30, 2020.

After conducting **COVID-19 readiness assessments in 16 hospitals** in Jordan, the Abt-led USAID HSD activity helped the facilities **develop response action plans** to mitigate gaps.

GROWING THE MOH'S SELF-RELIANCE



The percentage of women initiating **breastfeeding** within the first hour of birth **surged from 37 to 100 percent** because of the Abt-led Integrated Service Delivery Improvement Collaborative.

INNOVATING TO EXPAND HEALTH SERVICES DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC (DIGITAL SOLUTIONS)



The Abt-led USAID HSD activity co-developed

several key digital solutions with the MOH, including the COVID-19 Training Database, the Hospital Assessment and Preparedness Information System, and the enhanced Health Map Mobile application.
