




- Guidelines on the Partnership with Communities on Health Issues (GPCHI).

- Plans for the development of primary healthcare centers based on 2021-2025 national family medicine principles.
- Guidelines for facilitators at rural health centers to implement GPCHI.
- I2 CPGs on safe motherhood, infection prevention, clinical safety, emergency care for mothers and newborns, the management of physiological and complicated deliveries, antenatal care, and the management of obstetrics cases with COVID-19 complications.
- Demographic Health Survey 2017, including reports and key indicators.
- Medical statistical directories for 2014-2019, which allow facility managers and district leaders to learn about public health, medical facility activities, and indicator performance across institutions.
- SBCC materials, which are currently being gathered for uploading.




Data Visualization and Analysis in DHIS2



The Abt Monitoring and Evaluation Ecosystem




All data collected in CommCare (in facilities) is pushed into AMEE (DHIS2)



Lessons Learned

- Initial stakeholder buy-in at all levels on the digital strategy
- Limited digital infrastructure and internet
- Digital literacy
 - Basic training first: how to use smartphones and tablets
 - Virtual trainings in the time of COVID
- Staff turnover and training on new tools



Lessons Learned

- Replacing trusted paper tools with digital tools: it might be a mix
- What if the digital tools lose my data?
- Spurring investment in national Digital Health Roadmap
- Sustainability and transitioning to the Ministry of Health (tablets, servers, software)
