RESEARCH TO ACTION IN JAMAICA

The CMS Project (Research)

- Surveys led to development of intervention to improve access and usage of condoms among youth in Jamaica.
- Increases condom use and fosters youthfriendly health environment among health care providers.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT IN THE U.S.

Social Innovation Funding (Research and Technical Assistance)

- Identifying what works to increase economic opportunity, healthy futures and overall youth development.
- Builds evidence for Pay for Success models, financing methods and capacity building strategies in eight states.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT IN CENTRAL AMERICA

Cumple y Gana (Comply and Win) Program (Technical Assistance)

- Helped establish labor laws for women and youth in Costa Rica, the Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua.
- Increases awareness of labor rights, promoting methods for alternative dispute resolution and making labor inspections more effective.











GIRLS EMPOWERMENT/GENDER DEVELOPMENT EASTERN AND SOUTHERN AFRICA

Determined, Resilient, Empowered, AIDS-free, Mentored, Safe Women (DREAMS) Initiative (Technical Assistance)

- Addresses determinants of girls' HIV risk: poverty, gender equality, sexual violence and lack of education.
- Works in Kenya, Lesotho, Malawi, Mozambique, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT IN PAKISTAN

Empowering Pakistan: Jobs Project (Technical Assistance)

- Promotes job creation among youth and women.
- Established 15 new Career Development Centers and trained more than 6,800 people for high paying jobs in a variety of sectors.

GENDER IN INDIA

Gender Integration in Family Planning/ Couple Communication/Joint Decision-making (Technical Assistance)

- Monthly home visits to newly married women under 18 encourage delaying first births and spacing subsequent births.
- Nearly 60 percent of couples used family planning to space birth of their second child, and for women under 18, use of family planning methods increased.

HEALTHCARE IN SWAZILAND

Health Finance and Governance Child Friendly Courts (Technical Assistance)

- Provides counseling, health services, and special child-friendly courts for youth.
- Fosters environment for children to better speak out about their experiences, resulting in stronger evidence and more effective sentencing of offenders.

HEALTHCARE IN ZAMBIA

The Scaling Up Family Planning Project (Technical Assistance)

- Focuses on reaching adolescents and couples in underserved communities to increase uptake of long term reversible methods of contraception.
- Expands availability of choice of and access to quality family planning methods.

INCOME GENERATION IN SOUTH SUDAN

Agribusiness and Rural Markets II (FARM II) Project (Technical Assistance)

- Increases youth-specific farmer-based organizations, providing specialized interventions for their needs.
- Offers financial literacy and agriculture vocational skills, engaging youth to be key links in agricultural value chains.
